**To Register** return your application with a \$75 deposit for each session you wish to register for. The deposit will be applied to the total camp fee. In the event of cancellation, the deposit is not refundable. You can register online from our website (www.hoofbeat.org). Sorry, we cannot take phone or FAX registrations. Applications are accepted on a first-come basis. Confirmation will be sent after your application is received. If registering after May 1st, full payment is required.

**Family Discount:** If you enroll 2 or more children in Day Camp from your immediate family you may deduct 5% from the total Day Camp fee. To receive the discount, applications must be sent to us at the same time and received by May 1st.

# Day Camp Theme Weeks

While the main Day Camp program, stays the same each week, the themes vary from week-to-week. To help you decide, theme week descriptions are listed below:

**Horse Lover's** (girls only) -- We have fun for the horse-crazy girl in your family! In addition to daily riding, activities include mounted games, trail rides, special horse care classes, horsey crafts, and a mini-horse show.

**Adopt A Horse** (girls only) -- Campers will ride daily and each group will get to adopt their own horse for the week. Activities also include special classes about owning and feeding your own horse, trail rides, a horse show, horse crafts and introduction to English riding for the older group.

**Horse and Small Animal Care** (co-ed) -- For your animal lover we will have goats, a miniature horse, a calf and other special guests brought to you by our Hoofbeat staff. Activities include riding daily, trail rides, horse care classes and special animal care classes.

**Western Horsemanship** (co-ed) -- This week will have extra emphasis on Western horsemanship and showmanship. Activities include daily riding, trail rides, western show/rodeo events, campfire cooking, hayride, treasure hunt and a special presentation.

\* \* \* \* \*

Campers ride Western style Monday through Thursday for approximately 45 minutes (weather permitting). The length of time they ride on Friday depends on the theme week activities.

Weekly activities include a trail ride, horse care classes, hiking, crafts, sports and nature studies along with special activities relating to the theme for the week. While riding, campers must wear helmets, boots with a raised heel and smooth sole and long pants. We have SEI approved riding helmets and riding boots that your child may use if they don't have their own. (Bicycle helmets are not allowed).

Additional activities may include skits, drama, games, sing-alongs and free choice time. Water games and Friday trips to the pool may also be scheduled (weather permitting). In the event of inclement weather (heavy rain, excessive heat, etc.) we may substitute other activities in place of horseback riding or pool trips.

## Important Information About Day Camp

**Can my child be grouped with a friend?** Part of an enjoyable camp experience is making new friends. We find that when children are placed in large groups, it's difficult to make new friends with other campers. For this reason, we limit the group requests to only one, and they must be the same age.

**What if I need to cancel or change sessions?** Changes may be made prior to January 15th without penalty. After January 15th, a \$20 rescheduling fee will be charged for each session change. The fee charged for the new session will be the rate currently in effect. All cancellations and session changes must be in writing.

**What happens if the session I've chosen is full?** Sessions begin to fill about mid March or April. Our website information may not be updated daily, so we recommend that you call for availability before sending in your application. We also suggest that you indicate a 1st and 2nd choice on your application. If the session you want is full, you may request to be placed on our Waiting List and if an opening does not occur, your deposit will be returned.

**The total payment is due May 1st.** If registering after May 1st, full payment is required with your application .
